SENIOR SCHOOL RULES

Rules and regulations exist to encourage the highest possible standards of behaviour; and to enable the Academy community to run as smoothly as possible. Underpinning any system of regulations must be common sense, decency and concern for the well-being of others.

We expect that Academy pupils will recognise the need to behave in a way which graces the School, wherever they are. The Rector reserves the right to investigate and to take action on reports of unlawful, violent or indecent behaviour by a pupil, or behaviour which damages the reputation of the school, even if such behaviour takes place outwith school time or school premises.

Academy pupils share responsibility with the Rector and his staff for the maintenance of proper standards of decorum and discipline within the School. The Rector may suspend any pupil without notice for a serious breach of any of the School Rules. He may exclude a pupil permanently after consultation with the Chairman of the Court or other senior Directors.

The School Rules apply at the Academy, on the way to or from the Academy and at all events or expeditions connected with the Academy.

GENERAL

- 1 All should conduct themselves in a civilised manner wherever they are.
- 2 The following are forbidden:
 - Possession or consumption of alcohol, except on authorised occasions.
 - Possession or use of any drugs, other than those prescribed by a medical practitioner.
 - Possession or use of any knife or other weapon.
 - Bullying in any form.
 - Unauthorised possession of any item of property belonging to the School or any other person.
 - Possession or use of smoking materials.
 - Possession of any form of firework or of matches.
 - Possession of pornographic material.
 - All forms of gambling.
- 3 The School's Dress Regulations must be observed. Everyone should be of neat appearance at all times and hair must be of an acceptable length and style.
- 4 Everyone must observe all other Regulations and Notices which are brought to their attention or are displayed in the School.

COMING TO SCHOOL

5 No one is allowed to drive a motor vehicle to or from School on ordinary school days, unless parents have requested and received written permission from the Rector. No one may offer a lift to another Academy pupil unless both have first received separate written permission from the Rector. Such permission will be recorded on a school “driving licence”.

6 No one may be driven in a car by anyone other than a responsible adult to or from School or on any school occasion unless parents have requested and received written permission from the Rector. No one may ride pillion on a motor cycle to or from School or on any school occasion.

7 Eating in the streets or on public transport is not allowed; nor are the playing of personal stereos or the wearing of headphones.

8 Bicycles must not be ridden inside the Academy gates or Fields.

AT THE ACADEMY

9 No one may leave the School premises from 8.40 am until the end of school without the specific permission of a member of Staff. Pupils receiving such permission must sign out (and in again on their return) at the School Office.

10 Anyone who feels unwell or is injured should report to the School Nurse, failing whom to their Classteacher.

11 No one may enter any part of the school except for an authorised purpose; in particular, no other classroom may be entered in Breaks without permission. Specific instructions for the use of particular equipment or facilities must be strictly observed.

12 All must assemble in their classrooms at the first bell and in the Hall at the second bell. Anyone arriving late must report to the Year Heads’ Room, or after 9.20 to the School Office.

13 The use of personal stereos, or the playing of musical instruments is forbidden, unless specifically authorised.

14 Tennis balls alone are permitted for yard games, and then only up to 8.35 am, during breaks until the first bell, and after 4.15 pm. No ball games are permitted in the Gym Yard. Snowballing is not allowed at any time.

15 The utmost care must be taken of all School property, fabric and furnishing. Anyone causing damage must report it immediately to their Classteacher or to the person in charge where the damage has occurred, or to the Duty Teacher. Any pupil using the Academy’s computing facilities must act responsibly, heeding the standing orders published from time to time by the Computer Department.

16 The utmost care must be taken of personal property. All property must be clearly named. Anyone who loses property must report the loss at once to their Classteacher. Details of the Lost Property Scheme will be posted on classroom notice-boards.

ABSENCE

17 Leave of absence from school will be granted only for exceptional reasons. Early request must be made in writing to the Rector by parent or guardian.

18 Anyone who has to miss a school period for a music lesson or an interview or other reason should tell the member of Staff concerned in advance.

19 Parents are asked to phone the school by 9.30 am in the case of unexpected absence. Anyone who has been absent without previous notice must bring an explanatory note from parent or guardian on the next morning. In the case of absence longer than one day, the parent or guardian should post a letter to the Classteacher. It is the pupil's own responsibility to catch up work missed other than through illness.

SENIOR SCHOOL UNIFORM

These Dress Regulations are an integral part of the School Rules, and apply for every occasion connected with school, except occasions (eg certain expeditions) for which other dress is specifically ordered. No distinctive article of School dress may be worn unless the wearer is correctly dressed according to these regulations. Parents are asked to see that pupils comply exactly.

All articles of clothing brought to School must be clearly marked with name and initials.

The Academy has a **second-hand clothing shop** which is situated behind the dining hall of the Junior School in Arboretum Road. It is open twice a month during term time as advertised in the News Sheet.
